

**Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting, Town of Freedom, NH 03836
Monday, November 2, 2015**

Present: Leslie Babb, Neal Boyle, Ernest Day, Jr. Selectmen; Karen Hatch, Town Adm.; Scott Brooks, Road Agent and residents Lee Allison and Paul Clausen.

Upon arriving Scott Verney was informed that the naming of the bridge on Burnham had been given in 2008. The Road Agent will order ðBarryø Bridgeö and erect the sign either this fall or in the spring. Verney thanked all involved.

Brooks reported an incident with the newer one ton town truck; repairs will come out of the highway budget.

Mr. Clausen had mailed in a letter and map indicating the milfoil outbreak in Effingham; which the board reviewed.

Being there was no public comment Brooks continued with his highway update. He briefly reviewed the traffic counts that were done late summer. These will be forwarded to the board for further review.

Hatch reported that the tax bills had gone out earlier that day.

There had been a letter from a disgruntled resident regarding the assessor just showing up without prior notice. Hatch proposed that it be put in the town column and on the website. The board agreed that this was fine but that we would not go to the expense of a mailing. Hatch will respond to the letter.

The website was back up and running and there had been a meeting Friday with a web designer to see about upgrading our website as it was very outdated. His proposal will be in later in the week.
