Chief Cunio reported on the success of the fishing derby this past Sunday. There were 47 kids in attendance. He also explained the fire permits that are now online unless there are to burn brush piles then they must appear in person to acquire a permit.

Brooks encouraged the board to join him this weekend at the facility as it will be busy due to the holiday. Holiday hours are Saturday, Sunday and Monday and closed on Tuesday.

He reported that they are still building the compactor and it now looks like a June installation.

Hatch asked the board if they wanted to participate in the regional electric program through Lakes Region Planning. They asked that they review last year's data. There was also a brief discussion on the Tax Collector Internet Kiosk.

Fall updated the board on the meeting he and the road agent had with the engineer at Bergeron's office on the bid documents for the Danforth Bay Bridge replacement. The board decided that the bids would be open at a public Selectmen's meeting and not at the engineer's office. Fall also stated that physically we can't get through the process that it would take to do the replacement this fall. It will be a project scheduled for next summer. State monies will stay available if we are under contract.
